

Rules and Regulations

ASTM/SEI approved helmets are to be worn at all times when mounted.

All riders or parent/guardian (if rider is under 18) must sign a release. No one is allowed in the ring without a completed release.

Martingales are not permitted in any flat classes, equitation flat classes, or the flat phase of any Medal class. Unconventional tack or equipment will only be permitted at the judge's discretion.

The show management reserves the right to combine or split classes in accordance with all association guidelines and as they deem necessary.

The show management reserves the right to deny any entry.

River Glen Equestrian Park, The Show Management and all connections assume no liability for the loss or damage to any person or to personal property (including, but not limited to, death, injury, or damage to automobiles, trailers, horses, equipment, etc)

The horse show is governed by the rules of ETHJA. To be eligible for year-end awards, the exhibitor, the owner and the horse or pony must be registered. Applications are available from the show secretary.

Negative Coggins required. Recent EHV vaccine is strongly recommended.

Awards

Six 9" Ribbons will be awarded in each class. Six 12" Ribbons will be awarded in each Stake and Classic class. Six Sashes will be awarded in the Medals and Hunter Derby. 15" Champion and Reserve Ribbons will be awarded in all divisions. Additional Prizes will be awarded to all Division Champions.

River Glen Year End Circuit Awards - High Point Hunter, High Point Jumper and High Point Equitation Rider. There will be a one time recording fee for 2025 of \$10.00 for each horse/pony AND rider. The points for each horse/pony and rider will count as soon as they are recorded. At the end of the show series, the High Point Hunter, High Point Equitation Rider and High Point Jumper will be awarded the year-end award. Recording forms will be provided and should be filled out and given to the show secretary. You must record your horse or pony before the points will count.

\$150 Medal Classes

Judged on Rider's Equitation over a course set at 2' for the Mini Medal, 2' or 2'6 for the Pony Medal, and 2'6 or 3' for the Junior and Adult Medal. Testing on the flat is required (75% over fences, 25% flat). Further testing optional. USEF test 1-12.

Awards: Sash and Payout through 6th place.

There must be 4 entries to receive Prize Money.

\$150 Jumper Stakes

May be ridden by a professional, junior or amateur, and there is no limit to the number of horses a rider may compete in the class. <u>These stakes classes will be held at the end of their respective height sections.</u> **MUST ENTER STAKES SEPARATELY** from the

Low or High Jumper classes.

Low Jumper Stake: .45, .60, .70, .80, .85

High Jumper Stake: .90, 1.0, 1.05, 1.10, 1.15, 1.20, 1.25, 1.30

There must be 4 entries to receive Prize Money.

Awards: 12" Ribbons and Payout through 6th place. 1st-\$45, 2nd-\$35, 3rd-\$25, 4th-\$20, 5th-\$15, 6th-\$10

\$350 Hunter Derby

May be ridden by a professional, junior or amateur, and there is no limit to the number of horses a rider may compete in the class. First round (Classic round) will receive a base score plus 1 bonus point for each high option taken. The top 10 horses/ponies will return for the second (handy) round. Second round (Handy round) receives a base score plus 1 point for each high option taken. Judges may also award handy bonus points. Combined scores from both rounds will determine placings.

There must be 4 entries to receive Prize Money.

Awards: Sash and Payout through 6th place. 1st-\$100, 2nd-\$70, 3rd-\$60, 4th-\$50, 5th-\$40, 6th-\$30

Warm up class Judge's card to be open throughout the day. You may do your trip at any time.

Ground Rail Equitation: Open to amateur and junior riders who have not shown over fences. Courses must be trotted. Cantering will be heavily penalized. Riders may only cross enter into the ETHJA Cross Rail Equitation. Entering any other recognized ETHJA division will forfeit eligibility. To be judged on equitation and the rider's ability to effectively control the horse. This division will consist of three classes. Two over poles and one shall be a walk/trot flat class. Cross Rail Equitation: Open to amateur and junior riders who have not shown over fences. Courses must be trotted. Cantering will be penalized. Riders may only cross enter into the Ground Rail Equitation. Entering any other recognized ETHJA division will forfeit eligibility. To be judged on equitation and the rider's ability to effectively control the horse. This division will consist of three classes. Two over Cross Rails and one shall be a walk/trot flat class. Pleasure Hunter: Includes the following 3 classes: 1. Walk-trot under saddle 2. Walk-trot-canter under saddle 3. Hunter hack. To walk-trot-canter and to jump 2 fences at 18". Jumps may be verticals or cross rails. Boxes are not allowed. Show management must post a course for the Hunter hack class To be judged as a pleasurable ride, with manners and attitude to be taken into consideration. Since this division does not mimic a traditional hunter division, it will not count towards the year-end high point hunter award.

Beginner Rider Hunter: Open to amateur or junior riders on horses or ponies who have not shown over fences higher than 18". Riders may enter other classes with fences 18" and under, as well as any under saddle classes. Flat class to walk and trot. Fences 18".

Courses may be trotted and/or cantered. Simple changes not to be penalized. To be judged as a hunter class with emphasis on suitability and consistency.

Beginner Rider Equitation: Open to amateur or junior riders on horses or ponies who have not shown over fences 18" or higher. Riders may enter other classes with fences 18" or lower and any under- saddle classes. Flat class to walk and trot. Fences 18". Courses may be trotted or cantered. Simple changes not to be penalized. To be judged as an equitation class with emphasis on a riders' position, control and consistency in rhythm on course. Mini Hunter: Open to any rider on a horse or pony. Under saddle to walk/trot only. Fences 18" or 2'. No penalty for trotting on course. To retain Beginner Rider eligibility, these riders may only jump at 18". Short Stirrup: Open to riders 12 years and under. All riders must be in their first or second year of showing over fences at 2'. Pony/rider combination may not enter the Pony Hunter division at the same show. Fences 2'. May be combined with the Long Stirrup Hunter division

Long Stirrup: Open to amateur or junior riders 13 years or older. All riders must be in their first or second year of showing over fences at 2'. Fences 2'. Pony or horse/rider combination may not enter the Pony Hunter or the Children's Hunter division at the same show. May be combined with the Short Stirrup Hunter division.

2' Equitation: Open to short and long stirrup riders. Rider may not cross enter into any other equitation division, with exception of Mini Medal. Fences 2'.

Mini Medal: Open to junior or amateur riders on horses or ponies that are in their 1st or 2nd year of showing over fences at 2'. If a rider has competed in any other ETHJA Medal, the rider is ineligible for Mini Medal. Courses must have at least two (2) changes of direction. Testing on the flat is required (75% over fences 25% flat). Further testing is optional. USEF Tests 1-12. Fences 2' with no oxers.

Schooling Hunter: Open to all horses or ponies ridden by junior, amateur, or professional riders. Adults may ride ponies. Fences 2' or 2'6".

Pony Hunter: Open to junior riders on ponies. Fence heights: Smalls 2', Mediums 2' or 2'6", Large 2'6". USEF rules to apply with the exception of fence height.

All ETHJA sanctioned horse shows must charge a \$5.00 association fee per horse/rider combination entered in the show to be donated back to the association at the conclusion of each individual show weekend. Payment is due no later than 5 working days following the show weekend.

Pony Medal: Open to junior members on ponies. Courses must have at least two (2) changes of direction. Testing on the flat is required (75% over fences, 25% flat). Further testing optional. USEF tests 1 - 12. Fences 2' for small and medium ponies and 2'6" for large ponies. May be combined with the Junior and/or Adult Medal.

14&Under Equitation: Open to riders 14 years of age and younger. Fences 2' or 2'6". May be combined with any other age restricted equitation division. **Pre-Child/Pre-Adult Hunter:** Open to junior and amateur riders on horses. Fences 2'6". These classes may be split into a Pre-Child and/or Pre-Adult division at the show managements discretion.

Green Hunter: Open to horses and ponies in their first or second year of showing over fences exceeding 2'. May be ridden by any rider. Adults may ride ponies. Fences 2', 2'6" or 3'.

Equitation 15-17: Open to riders 15-17 years of age. Fences 2'6" or 3'. May be combined with any other age restricted equitation division.

<u>Junior Medal:</u> Open to Junior riders on horses. Courses must have at least two (2) changes of direction. Testing on the flat is required (75% over fences 25% flat). Further testing is optional. USEF Tests 1-12. Fences 2'6" or 3'0. May be combined with the Pony and/or Adult Medal.

Adult Equitation: Open to adult amateur riders. Fences 2'6" or 3'. May be combined with any other age restricted equitation division.

Adult Medal: Open to Adult riders on horses. Courses must have at least two (2) changes of direction. May be combined with the Pony and/or Junior Medal. Testing on the flat is required (75% over fences 25% flat). Further testing is optional. USEF Tests 1-12. f. Fences 2'6" or 3'0.

Low Hunter: Open to any rider on horses or ponies. Fences 3'. **Children's/Adult Amateur Hunter:** Open to junior or amateur riders on horses. Fences 3'.

Performance Hunter: Open to any horse or rider. Fences 3'3"- 4' **Junior/Amateur Owner:** Open to junior and amateur riders on horses. Fences 3'3"- 3'6".

Hunter Derby: Open to all members and registered horses and ponies. First round (Classic round) will receive a base score plus 1 bonus point for each high option taken. The top 10 horses/ponies will return for the second (handy) round. Second round (Handy round) receives a base score plus 1 point for each high option taken. Judges may also award handy bonus points. Combined scores from both rounds will determine placings. Places 1-6 will receive year-end ETHJA points. There must be 3 entries to fill the class. **Low Jumpers:** Fences under 0.85m (2'9"). Open to any horse/pony rider combination that has not shown in any ETHJA or USEF jumper competition over fences 0.85m (2'9") or higher in the respective competition year. High Jumpers: Fences 0.90m (2'11") or higher. Open to any horse/pony rider combination. There shall be no schooling allowed over fences in the show ring prior to the start of the class. Jumper courses must have a designated start/ finish line. In case of insufficient entries, High and Low Jumpers may be combined provided that all entrants jump the required fence height for their respective division.

CLASSICS: Horse shows may offer Hunter Classics once per year, consisting of 2 rounds, which shall receive double points, once yearly. Classics may only be listed as Beginner Rider Classic, Mini Classic, 2' Classic, 2"6" Classic, 3'0" Classic, 3'3"-3'6" Classic. Participants must declare for which division they wish their points to accrue upon entry. A singular horse/rider combination may only enter one classic per horse show weekend. Points may accrue in any recognized division offered at that show. 2 entries are required to fill classics. Hunter classics may be offered in two ways: A separate class with 2 rounds with double points awarded in any ETHJA hunter division offered at that show. The rider's first round score will come from a class in an ETHJA Hunter Division offered at that show which the rider designates as the division for which classic points will accrue. The show will designate which round in each division will be used as the first round's score. Show management must have this information designated in the results sent to the Points Secretary. Any show offering classics must print this entire rule in the prize list for the show offering classics. Horse shows may offer Jumper Classics once per year as a separate class with double points awarded in the ETHJA Low Jumpers and the High Jumpers divisions. 2 entries are required to fill classics. Show management must have this information designated in the results sent to the Points Secretary.

** ETHJA encourages and will support any decision to eliminate/disqualify exhibitors whose actions are deemed, by the judge, steward, or show management, to be not in the best interest of a horse, person, or the sport.**
